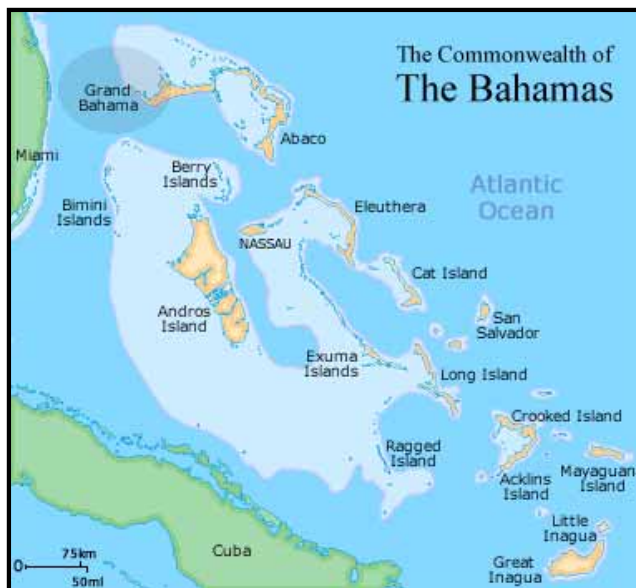

West End, The Bahamas

West End is the oldest city on Grand Bahamas Island (G.B.I.) and is considered its historical capital.



This picturesque fishing village is located 25 miles from Freeport and, as the name implies, is on the westernmost tip of the island. West End's biggest heyday was during Prohibition in the United States. West End, because of its close proximity to the States, was mainly a storage and transfer point for liquor from Canada, England, and Nassau before being ferried over to the mainland. In the 1940's, boaters from the States would make a point to stop over for a meal in the saloon or spend the night in its quaint surroundings. In 1988, the area fell on hard times with the closing of Jack Tar Village. Though the property stopped operating as a hotel, it gained new life as a native bar and restaurant managing to retain much of the past flavor. Today, despite two major hurricanes that devastated the area, West End is on the rise as a prime development location; second homes, a world class golf course and a marina complex are in the process of being erected on the out skirts of this sleepy fishing village.
